**Scope of Work:**

1. Utilize existing vertical and horizontal wire managers to “dress” existing patch cables.
2. Identify damaged patch panel ports and repair if possible. Otherwise, relocate to an available patch panel.
3. Provide materials and labor to install one new dedicated circuit and extend an existing circuit in the server room on the existing rack (location to be determined). Install two new twist lock 20 amp receptacles for equipment.
4. Report results of work to Technology Integration Group.

1. If jacks need to be replaced in the patch panels, replacement cost is \$13.06/jack.
2. Proposal does not include installation of UPS, servers, or switches provided by TIG.

If at any time during the term of this Agreement any dispute, difference, or disagreement shall arise upon or in respect of the Agreement, and the meaning and construction hereof, then every such dispute, difference, and disagreement shall be referred to a single arbiter agreed upon by the parties, or if no single arbiter can be agreed upon, an arbiter or arbiters shall be selected in accordance with the rules of the American Arbitration Association and such dispute, difference, or disagreement shall be settled by arbitration in accordance with the then prevailing expedited commercial rules of the American Arbitration Association, and judgment upon the award rendered by the arbiter may be entered in any court having jurisdiction thereof. Arbitration shall be conducted in Multnomah County, Oregon. The then prevailing Oregon Rules of Evidence and the Oregon Rules of Civil Procedure shall apply in any such arbitration.*

*ATTORNEY FEES. In the event an arbitration, suit or action is brought by any party under this Agreement to enforce or interpret any of its terms, or in any appeal therefrom, it is agreed that the prevailing party shall be entitled to reasonable attorneys fees to be fixed by the arbitrator, trial court, and/or appellate court.*

*PRESUMPTION. This Agreement or any section thereof shall not be construed against any party due to the fact that said Agreement or any section thereof was drafted by said party.*



*TITLES AND CAPTIONS. All article, section and paragraph titles or captions contained in this Agreement are for convenience only and shall not be deemed part of the context nor affect the interpretation of this Agreement.*

*ENTIRE AGREEMENT. This Agreement contains the entire understanding between and among the parties and supersedes any prior understandings and agreements among them respecting the subject matter of this Agreement.*

*AGREEMENT BINDING. This Agreement shall be binding upon the heirs, executors, administrators, representatives, successors and assigns (if permitted) of the parties hereto.*

*FURTHER ACTION. The parties hereto shall execute and deliver all documents, provide all information and take or forbear from all such action as may be necessary or appropriate to achieve the purposes of this Agreement.*

*GOOD FAITH, COOPERATION AND DUE DILIGENCE. The parties hereto covenant, warrant and represent to each other good faith, complete cooperation, due diligence and honesty in fact in the performance of all obligations of the parties pursuant to this Agreement. All promises and covenants are mutual and dependent.*
